Cleansing Nigeria from Christians

On December 2022, the US Department of State omitted Nigeria from placing on the list of **Countries of Particular Concern**. Historically, countries who are dealing with issues regarding religious freedoms are placed onto this list for the USA to take into consideration and take action in keeping other countries accountable to religious freedom through the International Religious Freedom Act of 1998. Various accounts of Christian persecution occurring in Nigeria have been reported, including many deaths.

As Christians, any life taken is one too many, as we are told to love one another, even our enemies. Ultimately, God should be the one who chooses whether to take life away. Accounts of Christians being "cleansed" from Nigeria by Fulani Jihadist have been reported to be occurring as a way to "ethnically cleanse Nigeria from Christians through government cooperation militia," Joel Veldkamp reports (See link below).

This phrase alone should encourage Christians around the globe to pray for their brothers and sisters suffering for their faith. Scripture reminds us through the writings of Paul in Romans chapter 5

"... we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us." Only the Holy Spirit can give us the strength to endure persecution. Let us pray for Nigeria.
