On behalf of our board of directors we are thrilled that Timbella Foundation is helping us provide some of the essential basic needs of the rural children in Cambodia. These extra funds help to empower them with education and skills training, which is very difficult to attain in Cambodia without support and finances from people who care and are committed to restoring dignity and an improved standard of living.

We are very proud to announce that some of our young people from the Children's Home are achieving good results both at school and university. Our leaders are dedicated to guiding them in their strengths and goals for the future and teaching the young people Christian morals and understanding.

We are at present providing a new well and toilet in the poor areas of Kom Pong Cham Province which will improve sanitation and health standards. In September a small team from Western Australia will be travelling up to our projects, to spend time teaching and giving guidance to the staff in two of the different areas where we support students. These young people love our visits and as we enjoy games, stories and food together the close bond is built between us.

We also support two remote villages where there are elderly men and women who have serious health conditions and many of them are caring for grandchildren and making every effort to educate these young people. Our financial assistance is a God gift to them and greatly appreciated. We will keep you informed of the developments in our programs and extend our love and appreciation to everyone.
